## **Inspirus Credit Union donates three LaserJet printers to the Federal Way School District.**

The printers were previously used by the credit union and range from one year to 13 years old. The three printers were picked up by [Copiers Northwest](#) and will be serviced before being sent to the district.

Inspirus Credit Union Vice President of Information Technology Kris Hanson said, "We are happy to give our gently used printers to the Federal Way School District. We are always looking for ways to support the schools in our area, and this is one small way we give back to education."

The printers are worth an estimated \$1,000. This cost will offset the districts expenses and support the schools budget for IT expenditures.
