

How to gain access to Credit Card, eStatements, eNotices, and PayDough services within the Digital Banking Platform

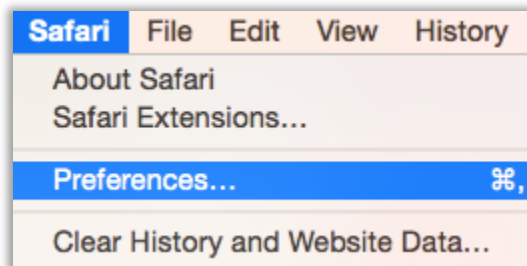
To easily view the 3rd party services listed above, you'll need to adjust your browser settings to allow Pop-ups and 3rd Party Cookies.

Safari 9 and 10

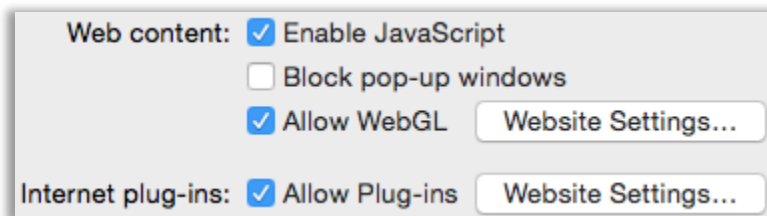
Step 1: From the **Safari** menu, select **Preferences...**



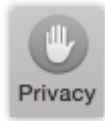
Step 2: Click on the **Security** icon



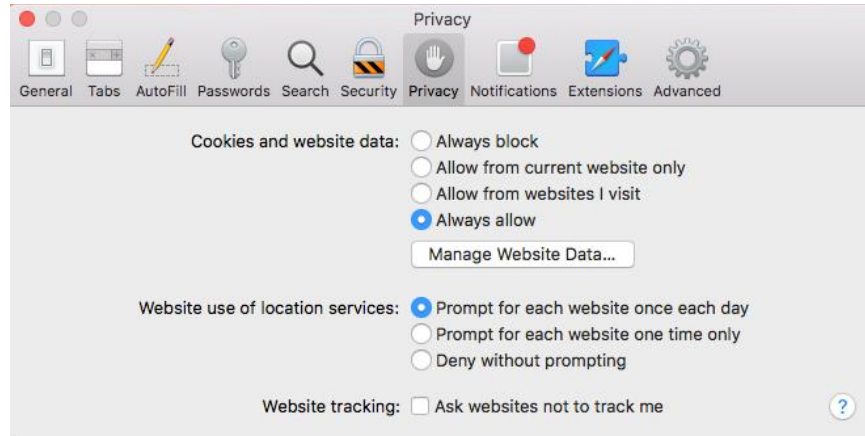
- Make sure the following option is **not checked**:
 - Block pop-up windows



Step 3: Click on the **Privacy** icon




- Next to “Cookies and website data,” make sure **Always allow** is selected



Step 4: Close the Preferences window and **restart Safari**

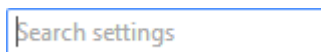
Google Chrome


Step 1: Click the menu icon  in the upper right corner of the browser, just to the right of the website address bar:



Step 2: Select “Settings” from the drop-down menu


Step 3: Locate the “Search settings” box near the top of the page and type in the word “Privacy”



Step 4: Click on the  button

Step 5: Be sure that the following options are set for each section*:

- **Cookies:**
 - **check** option to "Allow local data to be set (recommended)"
 - **uncheck** option to "Block third-party cookies and data"
- **JavaScript**
 - **check** option to "Allow all sites to run JavaScript (recommended)"
- **Pop-ups**
 - **check** option to "Allow all sites to show pop-ups"


**For each of the above options, advanced users can set our URL as an exception, instead of setting a global rule by selecting *

Step 6: Click 

Firefox

Step 1: Click the  menu button

Step 2: Click on **Options** (PC) or **Preferences** (Mac)

Step 3: Click the  menu option

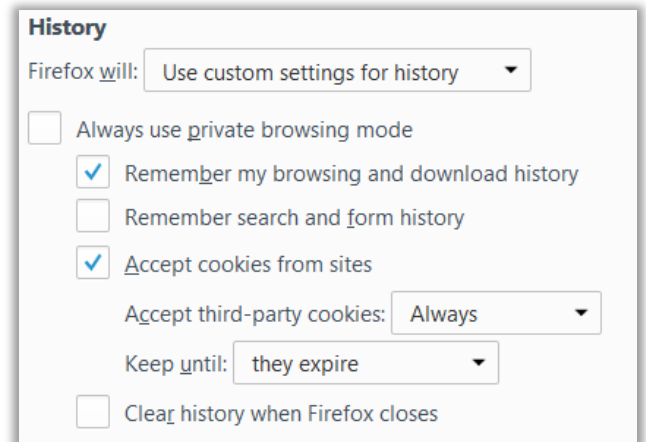
Step 4: *Block pop-up windows* needs to be **unchecked***

Step 5: Click on the  menu option

Step 6: In the History section, set the *Firefox will:* drop-down menu to *Use Custom Settings for History*.

Then:


- **Check** the following boxes
 - Remember my browsing and download history
 - Accept cookies from sites*
 - Accept third-party cookies: **Always**
 - Keep until: **they expire**
 - **Uncheck** the following boxes
 - Always use private browsing mode
 - Clear history when Firefox closes

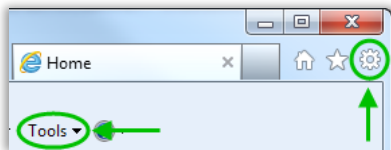


Step 7: Close the **Options/Preferences** tab

**Advanced users can set our URL as an exception, instead of setting a global rule.*

Internet Explorer

Step 1: Click the **Gear Wheel** icon  near the top right corner of your browser *or* select **Tools** from the Menu Bar, if it is enabled



Step 2: Select "Internet Options"

Step 3: Then, click the **Privacy** menu tab

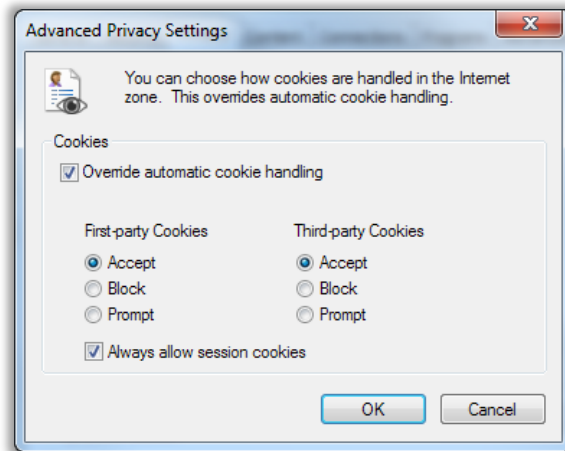


Step 4: Turn on Pop-up Blocker needs to be **unchecked***



Step 5: Still under the Privacy tab, click on the **Advanced** button (not the menu tab)


- *Override automatic cookie handling* needs to be **checked***
- Both *First Party Cookies* and *Third Party Cookies* needs to be set to **Accept***
- *Always allow session cookies* needs to be **checked***

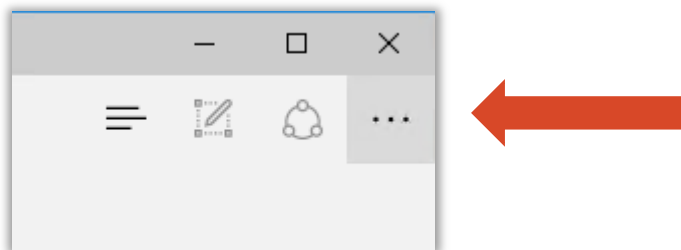


- Click **OK**

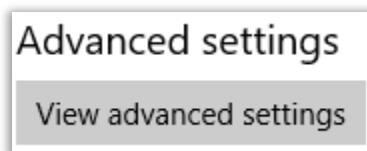
Microsoft Edge (Windows 10 default browser)

Step 1: Click the  menu button in the top right corner of the browser.

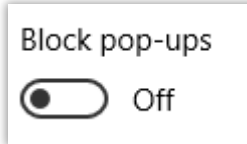


Step 2: Select "Settings" from the drop down menu

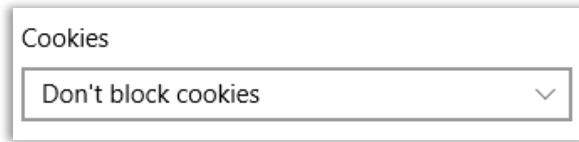
Step 3: Scroll down the Settings list and click the "View advanced Settings" button




Step 4: In the next window, turn off the "Block pop-ups" setting



Step 5: Scroll further down on the same window and set the "Cookies" drop down to "Don't block cookies"



Step 6: Click the  menu button to close the "Settings" panel.
